Advice on the Interchangeability of Pandemic H1N1 Influenza Vaccines used in
Australia and Overseas

It is not advised to mix swine flu vaccine schedules as there are no data (safety or immunogenicity), particularly on mixing a non-adjuvanted with an adjuvanted vaccine or a live attenuated with inactivated vaccine. Therefore, where feasible, the same type of vaccine should be used in a two-dose schedule.

However, if a child has had a non-adjuvanted swine flu vaccine from another manufacturer, a second dose in Australia of Panvax[®] H1N1 vaccine would be anticipated to provide a good boost response (and vice versa).

If the first dose has been with an adjuvanted or live attenuated swine flu vaccine, a second dose with Panvax[®] H1N1 vaccine should, on first principles, give a good boost and likely a satisfactory protective response.
